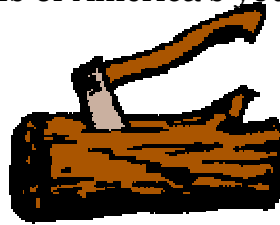

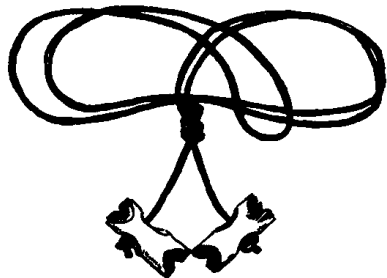

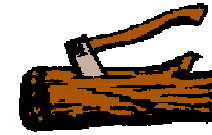

WHAT IS WOOD BADGE



Baden-Powell took the first step in training Scout leaders by organizing a series of lectures for Scouters in 1911. He instituted Wood Badge training in 1919.

The primary purpose of today's Wood Badge experience is to strengthen Scouting in our units, districts, and local councils.

WHAT IS A TICKET

The Wood Badge “ticket” represents the participant’s commitment to completing a set of goals related to that individual’s Scouting position. The ticket gives the participants an opportunity to practice and demonstrate a working knowledge of leaderships skills presented during the course.

Upon successful completion of the Wood Badge course and ticket the participant will receive a certificate and the distinctive neckerchief, woggle, and beads.
